<b>Generic action</b>	<b>5.1 Implement trainings of pre-professionalization and professionalization for the socially excluded persons</b>
<b>Common transnational action</b>	<b>5.1.1 Experimentation of pre-professional trainings for the integration of socially excluded persons</b>
<b>Objectives of the common transnational action</b>	<b>Pre-professional training:</b> Intended for the socially excluded persons, preparatory of a vocational training. Facilitate the access to the employment for the socially excluded persons Facilitate the connection between the marine leisure professions. Inform about the employment problem in the nautical sector and facilitate a better adaptation between the job offer in the marine sector and the demand
<b>Target of the action (public, actors, sites)</b>	School children, socially excluded persons: young people and adults in employment research, who are provided by a local structure in charge of social integration

Common contents 6 to 8 weeks
